Customer Al Acceptable Use Policy

Last Updated: April 1, 2025

- 1. <u>Overview</u>. This AI Acceptable Use Policy ("**AI Policy**") is incorporated by reference into the Terms and Conditions of Use ("**Terms**") on the Website and applies to your use of any AI Features made available to you by Duquesne Light Company ("**DLC**").
- 2. Definitions.
 - a. **"Artificial Intelligence**" means any technology that enables machines to perform tasks that typically require human intelligence, including but not limited to generative AI, machine learning, natural language processing, and computer vision.
 - b. **"AI Features**" means software and systems that utilize Artificial Intelligence, including proprietary and third-party solutions.
 - c. "Input" means information you enter into the AI Features.
 - d. "**Output**" means an answer, solution, result, and/or new material generated an AI Tool using an Input.
 - e. "You" or "Your" means the individual authorized to use the AI Features.
- 3. <u>Application</u>. This AI Policy applies to you and the organization that you represent when using the AI Features.
- 4. Acceptable Use.
 - a. The AI Features must be used:
 - i. in strict compliance with this AI Policy and the Terms;
 - ii. in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, including applicable data protection and privacy laws; and
 - iii. in a manner that does not infringe on any other party's intellectual property rights or violate any terms of service or licensing agreements to which you are a party.
 - b. The AI Features may not be used:
 - i. to harass, bully, intimidate, or discriminate against other users of the AI Features or external third parties;
 - ii. to engage in any activity that could compromise the security, confidentiality, availability, and/or integrity of the AI Features and/or DLC's systems, networks, or other applications, including attempting to access unauthorized data, systems, networks, or applications in connection with the use of the AI Features; or

- iii. to generate individualized advice that in the ordinary course of business would be provided by a licensed professional (e.g., financial or legal advice).
- 5. <u>Prohibited Inputs</u>. The following types of content may not be used as an Input in connection with the AI Features:
 - a. <u>Copyrighted Material</u>: Content from any copyrighted books, articles, songs, websites, code repositories, or other media without the express permission of the copyright holder.
 - b. <u>Personal Information</u>: Personally identifiable information, including but not limited to, names, addresses, phone numbers, health-related data, financial information, social security or tax identification numbers.
 - c. <u>Hate Speech</u>: Content promoting hate, discrimination, or violence against individuals or groups based on certain characteristics.
 - d. Illegal Activity: Content that encourages or promotes illegal activity.
 - e. <u>Explicit Content</u>: Graphic violence, pornography, or other adult content that would be deemed objectionably offensive.
 - f. <u>Misleading Information</u>: Deliberately inaccurate, false, or misleading information, such as impersonation of another individual, or organization.
 - g. <u>Malicious Code</u>: Content that includes or attempts to introduce malware, viruses, or harmful software into the AI Features or DLC's systems or networks.
- 6. <u>Restrictions</u>. In connection with your use of the AI Features, you may not:
 - a. License, sublicense, sell, resell, distribute, rent or lease, transfer, assign, time share or otherwise commercially exploit or make available the AI Features to any third party;
 - b. Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or otherwise attempt to discover the source code, models, or algorithms of the AI Features;
 - c. Copy, modify or create derivative works based on the AI Features or conduct benchmark, load, storage or other similar testing;
 - d. Share your login credentials with any third-party;
 - e. Probe, scan, or test the vulnerability of any DLC system or network, or breach or circumvent any security or authentication measure associated with the AI Features;
 - f. Access or search the AI Features by any means other than as permitted hereunder;
 - g. Use the AI Features to commercialize any product or service that is similar to or competitive with the AI Features; or
 - h. Delete from the AI Features any documentation, legal notices, disclaimers, or proprietary notices, such as copyright or trademark notices, or modify any DLC logos.
