We understand you may be facing financial hardships during the ongoing pandemic. To support those in need through the months ahead and well after, Duquesne Light Company (DLC) has introduced an online self-service payment arrangement tool to make it easier for qualified residential customers to pay their electric bill.

DLC's new payment arrangement tool is designed to help you easily spread unpaid account balances across manageable monthly installments, which will be billed along with current monthly charges.

The online process is broken out into five easy steps, giving you the option to make an up-front payment, calculate monthly installments and determine how long it will take to pay off unpaid balances.

Visit us online at DuquesneLight.com/Arrangement to see if you're eligible for a payment arrangement. If you're already enrolled, you can make changes by providing your updated information. To use the online payment arrangement portal, you must be an active residential customer.

Do you need help paying your electric bill? We're here to help. The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and the Dollar Energy Fund offer grants to help you pay your electric bill. Check if you qualify for assistance grants by reviewing the income eligibility guidelines in the chart on the back page. Eligible customers don't have to pay the money back and no lien will be placed against your home. But you should ACT QUICKLY before funds expire.

Duguesne Light's Customer Assistance Program (CAP) offers an affordable payment plan for qualified, income eligible households that have an inability to pay based on the chart on the back page. The plan assists these households in maintaining electric service by providing a reduced monthly payment and arrearage forgiveness. Customers enrolled in CAP also can

assist you if you have an emergency situation and are in jeopardy of losing your heat. Emergency situations include broken heating equipment or leaking lines that must be fixed or replaced; lack of fuel; danger of being without fuel (less than a 15-day supply); or having utility service terminated (received a notice that service will be shut off within the next 60 days).
